If the tuition payment is made in full on or before June 1st there is **an additional 3% discount on tuition only**, in addition to sibling discounts. **The additional 3% discount will not be allowed after June 1st.**

The sibling discount consists of a 10% discount for the second child and 15% for the third, or any additional children, on tuition only.

Long Term Improvement Fee \$ 350.00 Due by April 30th

This fee supports renovation, improvement, and expansion of facilities and programs. This includes planning, construction, debt retirement, and associated administrative and personnel expenses. A detailed list of these items is available in the business office.

Tuition Payments Through SMART = 10 monthly installments - \$43.00 annual SMART fee

Yearly tuition payment may be divided into 10 monthly installments, June 2009 through March 2010, made payable to SMART Tuition Management, Inc. Each family wishing to pay in monthly payments is responsible for enrolling with SMART, for an annual fee of \$43 per family. This enrollment is available through the school business office.

Financial Aid

Financial aid for tuition is available to students who qualify. All applications are kept confidential. If you are considering applying for financial aid for the 2009-2010 school year, you must get your application in to SSS immediately. Because of the school's need to finalize operating budget and financial decisions, the deadline for submitting applications is February 13th for returning students and March 1st for all others. You may still submit later applications; however, awards may not be available for late submissions. Filing online is the quickest way to process your application. The website is www.nais.org/financialaid/sss. The fee for filing is \$24.00. Please note that the online filing is much more efficient and reports are available to the school faster.

BASE (Before/After School Enrichment)

Tuition covers the hours between 8:00 a.m.-3:00 p.m. for the grades and 8:00 a.m.-12:00 noon for the kindergarten. Between 6:45 and 8:00 a.m. and after school until 5:30 p.m., BASE is available at \$3.25 per hour, \$2.75 per hour for two or more children using BASE within a month. You will be billed separately for hours used.

Lunch

For the current school year, 2008-09, lunches are \$3.50, Chef or Caesar salads are \$4.00, and milk or juice is \$.30 extra. (Prices are subject to change, if needed, to adjust for any vendor increases for school year 2009-2010.)

Additional Expenses

All students will be required to wear designated uniforms each week, Monday through Thursday. Dress for "Free Fridays" must be in compliance with the dress codes that are spelled out in the parent/student handbooks or this privilege will be revoked. For uniform options, please see the HNES uniform policy.

Field Trips

Please note that some of our classes participate in educational field trips during the school year. These field trips may be an additional expense for the students involved. Field trips at Holy Nativity are determined by and tied to the curriculum. Fourth grade studies Florida history and has traditionally traveled to St. Augustine (c. \$400.00 per person). Sixth grade attends Space Camp at Cape Canaveral, FL, or Huntsville, AL for three days (c. \$380.00 per person). The eighth grade class goes to Washington, D.C. and New York City for six days (c. \$1,300.00 -\$1,500.00 per person). Financial aid for field trips is available for students when needed and is confidential (see Head of School).
